The Import Promotion Desk (IPD) connects buyers with South African cut flower growers who offer the impressive diversity of the fynbos flora. This flora, which includes Proteas, Leucodendrons, Leucospermums and Brunias, is unique to the south-west of the country. In particular, the King Protea, South Africa's national flower, reflects the importance of the fynbos biome and adorns the country's coat of arms in a stylised form.

For the first time, IPD is presenting the South African range at the International Plant Fair (IPM) in Essen – in cooperation with the industry association "Cape Flora South Africa". The small and medium-sized flower farms specialise in the cultivation, wild collection and breeding of fynbos.

The sustainable approach of the flower farms and the strict regulation of wild collection help to preserve the diversity of species and biodiversity in South Africa. While cultivated cut flowers last longer thanks to targeted care and irrigation, wild collection complements the range with varieties that are difficult to grow, such as Silver Brunia.

All companies that we introduce have been pre-screened by us and our partner Cape Flora. The promising companies are able to reliably serve the seasonal demand in the EU market.

In our selection process, we pay attention not only to product quality, exportability and compliance with international standards and certifications, but also to the efficiency of logistics.

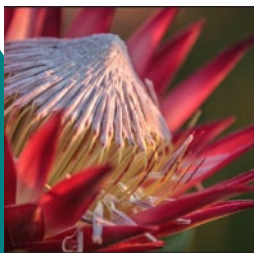


IPD partner Cape Flora South Africa

Concordia Flowers is a 1,100-hectare eco-friendly farm (95% solar powered) located in the Fynbos heartland of the Western Cape, South Africa. The farm comprises 17 hectares of cultivated Proteas and Leucospermum and 900 hectares of natural Fynbos.

The team of 20, 80% of whom are women, harvest, sort, grade, bouquet and pack all on site. Fynbos thrives in a unique coastal and mountainous environment, renowned for its biodiversity and part of the Cape Floral Kingdom. The flowers and foliage come in a variety of colours and shapes, adapt to seasonal changes and require fire to complete their life cycle.



Concordia Flower Exporters aims to expand globally by supplying high quality fresh fynbos, proteas and bouquets to international markets.

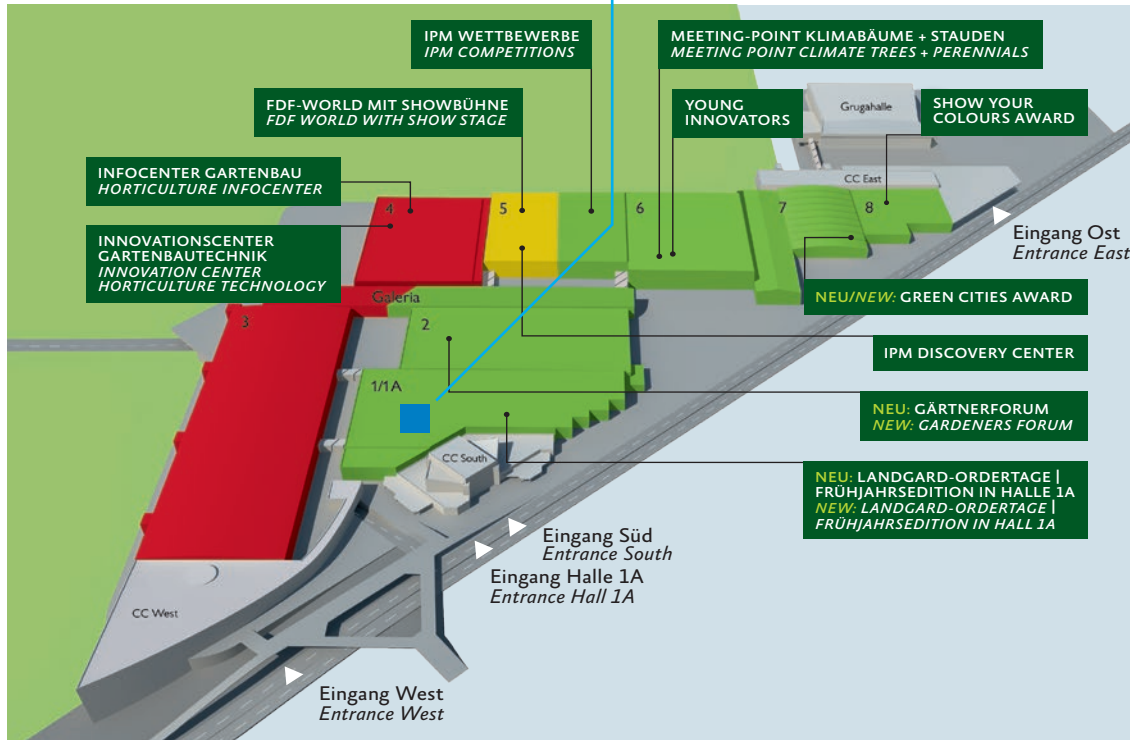


Floorplan
