Bio Amandes was created in 2018 by Eric NGuetta, a young Ivorian whose main concern was to offer quality and traceable shea butter while promoting local traditional know-how. Bio Amandes produces shea butter using modern technology offering the highest quality shea butter (international standards) while preserving the artisanal skill of extraction and production.

Bio Amandes employs 41 people and exports mainly to Europe (France, Germany, The Netherlands). The company's corporate social responsibility is dedicated to the empowerment of rural women involved along the processing chain.

Plantivoire is an agro-industrial company with four production sites, founded in 1991. They manage 2,429 hectares of land, including 375 hectares of natural forest, which has been voluntarily protected since the company was founded. Their core activities focus on the production of premium essential oils. These include cold-pressed citrus essential oils (bergamot, bigarade, lemon) and essential oils obtained by distillation (ginger, petit grain, turmeric and more). In addition to its oil palm plantation, Plantivoire markets a portion of the fresh lemon it produces. The company produces essential oils that meet the highest standards of olfactory quality, delivering exceptional products to its customers.

As a socially and environmentally responsible company, Plantivoire is committed to protecting the environment, its employees and the rural communities neighbouring its production sites. This commitment was formally recognised in 2021 through its For Life certification.

Looking to the future, Plantivoire has embarked on an ambitious program to renew its orchard. This initiative will allow to double the current production by 2029.

It is used for cosmetic formulations maintaining or improving all the technical performance of standard synthetic ingredients.

Natural white tagua powder can be used as an exfoliant, sensory enhancer, whitening agent and smoothing agent. Also, as a natural substitute for PMMA, talc and titanium dioxide. Tagua powder is a non-perishable ingredient that has several applications such as body and face scrubs, make-up, creams or natural pigment carrier.

The use of natural white tagua powder directly supports the conservation of rainforests in Ecuador, where tagua palms grow wild. It also contributes to improving the living conditions of local communities, who obtain an income by sustainably collecting tagua seeds, becoming the best guardians of these ecosystems and biodiversity.

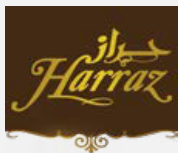

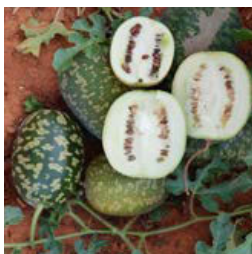
